Waste Management Categories

Rigid Plastics

- ▲ Plastic bottles (Beverages, shampoo, lotion, etc)
- ▲ Plastic oil containers/ Cans
- ▲ PVC Window frames, plumbing pipes
- ▲ Disposable glasses, cutlery, food containers, straws in clean condition
- ▲ Tetrapaks
- ▲ CD or cassette covers
- ▲ Yoghurt or ice-cream containers
- ▲ Plastic stationery
- ▲ Empty medicine containers
- ▲ Broken or used toys

Flexible Plastic

- ▲ Milk or oil pouches in clean and dry condition
- ▲ Plastic bags (all micron size)
- ▲ Medicine blister packets
- ▲ Chips / Biscuit covers and trays inside them in clean and dry condition
- ▲ Thermocol
- ▲ Snout pouches and sachets
- ▲ Plastic flowers or curtains
- ▲ Laminate tubes (toothpaste, facewash, etc)
- ▲ Gift Wrapping paper
- ▲ Medical xrays
- ▲ E-commerce wrapping plastic (bubble wrap, sling wrap, foam)



- Paper**
- ▲ Newspaper or white paper
 - ▲ Magazines
 - ▲ Books
 - ▲ Shipping cartons
 - ▲ Paper boxes (soap, toothpaste, medicine, perfume)
 - ▲ Cardboard

- Glass**
- ▲ Glass bottles
 - ▲ Glass containers
 - ▲ Broken glass bottle
(Pack it separately and label to avoid injury)
 - ▲ Beverage bottles

- Metal**
- ▲ Aluminium or tin cans or Aerosol containers
 - ▲ Metal utensils
 - ▲ Metal Fixture or fittings
 - ▲ Metal frames or rods

- Used Cooking Oil**
- ▲ Store it in a dry Plastic or Glass container
